Schedule of Events:

Event 1: The John Molloy Singles - 100 16 yard Singles.

Prizes will be awarded to the Singles Champion and Class Winners. All prizes awarded using the Lewis Classification System. Cost: \$20.00.

Event 2: The Roger Bidgood 2 Man Team Award – Singles.

Teams will be chosen at random. AA Class shooters will be paired with a remaining shooter and the Award goes to the team with the highest combined score.

Event 3: 50 Pair Doubles (100 targets).
